TOPIC: Financial Advisor

Amanda's market is "normal people." Everyone works and puts away what they can.

As a fiduciary, she is required to put the interests of her clients first. Not all financial advisors are fiduciaries. Edward Jones has a field supervisory department that watches every trade placed. If they question an activity, the advisor must provide a satisfactory rationale. Not all firms have this kind of oversight.

Edward Jones is considered a conservative firm. Investments are typically long term based on past performance.

Amanda reviews all of her clients' portfolios approximately once a month. She usually meets with them face to face once a year, but she talks to them more frequently. She contacts clients if analyst opinions on investments significantly change. Goals are set with clients based on their individual objectives.

For businesses, Amanda can help setting up SEP IRAs for self-employed people and 401K plans for larger businesses. She also explained that a Simple IRA is similar to a SEP IRA although less can be put away.

She offers fee based service (1.8%) which includes everything. Alternatively, clients can "pay as they go" by paying commissions. Consultations are free.

The financial planning process is pretty much the same regardless of what you are looking to save for. She looks at what money is coming in, what money is going out, what is most important to the client and what the client's dream is. She tries to get very specific with the dream. She also helps clients assess their risk tolerance. Finally, she develops a portfolio that is expected to meet the individual's goals. This includes tailoring portfolios to the client's desire for Socially Responsible Investing – what do you want to stay away from such as guns and tobacco.
